

SHOOT RULES

1. This shoot is being held at the White Mark Bowmen Archery Clubs' ground and we ask you all to respect these facilities. White Mark operates a **No Smoking** policy on the course and in the club house
2. This shoot is open to MSS members and guests holding any UK recognised archery association membership card.
3. This shoot is only open to traditional (wooden bows in any pre 1900 style) bows shooting wooden arrows. No crossbows permitted.
4. Membership cards must be produced at registration and you will be required to sign in on an MSS participant sheet
5. The rules of shooting of the MSS, EFAA and White Mark Bowmen apply at this shoot. A full list is available on request.
6. There is no official dress code for this shoot so feel free to dress in period costume or normal shooting kit. Remember we are shooting in woodland.
7. Parking is limited at this venue so please vehicle share if possible.
8. On arrival please park as directed by the stewards
9. Registration will open at 9.00 am with the shoot commencing at 10.00 am sharp.
10. Once you have registered enter your name on the target lists provided. Initially we require 4 archers per target.
11. There will be 28 targets (2 x 14) with round 1 being shot prior to lunch and round 2 after lunch. Cumulative score to count for prizes.
12. Please bring your own refreshments
13. All other specific shoot rules will be explained during the shoot briefing
14. Shooting must not commence until you hear the blast from the air horn.
15. This shoot is a four arrow per target shoot with arrows to be shot as per the red pegs (black pegs for cubs) or posted instructions.
16. All arrows score as follows: **Inner Kill = 10 points Outer Kill = 8 points, Wound = 5 points, Fur/Feather/Hoof = 1 point**
17. At least two archers should shoot together wherever safely possible.
18. On each peg the lead foot should touch the peg unless there are two archers shooting from the same peg in which case the lead foot should be in line with the peg.
19. When shooting in line you should ensure that in round 1 you always shoot from the same side and in round 2 the opposite side. (That is shoot one round from the left of the peg and one round from the right of the peg)
20. Ensure you keep to the marked lanes and paths throughout the shoot.
21. Remember to leave a bow or fellow archer in front of the target when looking for lost arrows behind targets.
22. All lost arrows should be recorded and reported to shoot control. Include a description/colour of arrow and target number.
23. At least one member of each shooting group should carry a whistle. In the event of emergency 3 loud blasts of the whistle at 15 second intervals will summon assistance. **ALL** archers should cease shooting if this warning is heard and then recommence shooting on the sound of the air horn. Any incidents during the shoot must be reported to shoot control. First Aid kits are in the club house.
24. Please ensure that you take all of your rubbish home with you and leave as quietly as possible. We may want to use this facility again in the future.
25. Above all remember this is a fun shoot

At the end of the shoot we will need to replace White Marks' targets and cover the butts.
Your assistance would be greatly appreciated.

The MSS and its' officers trust you will enjoyed this shoot and look forward to seeing you at one of our future events.
